(CVG) is the eighth largest cargo airport in North America and the 34th largest in the world.

- **Industry cluster:** Greater Cincinnati is the second most competitive location in North America for aviation & aerospace (Source: *Site Selection Magazine*, 2015)
- **SOAR:** The Southwest Ohio & Northern Kentucky Aerospace Region (SOAR) is a 27 county region in Southwestern Ohio, Northern Kentucky and Southeast Indiana that is one of 12 federally-designated manufacturing communities by the US Department of Commerce. This designation gives preferential status on a number of federal grants, a point of contact within the federal government to navigate grant opportunities, and the ability to brand the Greater Cincinnati/Dayton region as a center of US Aerospace Manufacturing.

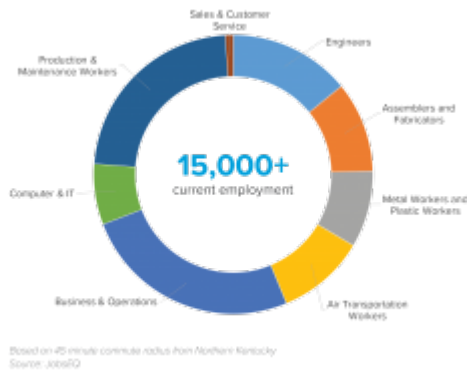
Workforce

Northern Kentucky's total labor shed is over 1 million adults, with 15,000 people currently employed in aviation and aerospace. The talent pipeline features more than 6,000 engineering graduates per year within 100-miles and rapidly growing manufacturing technician programs at Gateway Community & Technical college.
